

ACCESSING THE LAKES: FOBS, REMOTES, CALLBOX

1. FOBS

Fobs are oval-shaped electronic devices that fit on a keyring. They need to be waved in front of a scanner to open a lock.

Fobs will open all of the pedestrian gates, pool gates, tennis court gates, and the clubhouse door.

Fobs will also open the front vehicle gate. The fob scanner for the front vehicle gate is to the left of the keypad at the guard shack.

Fobs cost \$25.00

2. REMOTES (CLICKERS)

Remotes are rectangular black devices that require you to click their built-in button to open the vehicle gate at the building entrance. That is the only thing the remote will open.

You can click the remote while you are driving up to the gate and it will open.

Remotes cost \$50.00
